



- SIDING NAIL Wide flat head, ribbed shaft.





Shiplap Siding is available in a wide assortment patterns with smooth, rough, or saw-textured surface options. Shiplap siding provides a traditional-style appearance. This pattern allows for a 1/2" overlap (B). Allow for an approximate 1/8" gap (C) when installing patterns 8" or wider.
