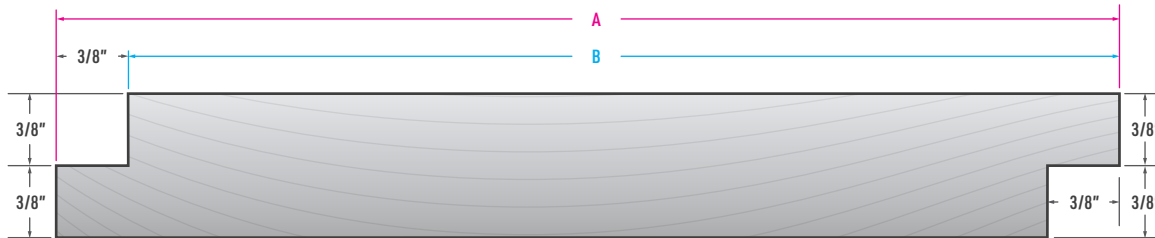

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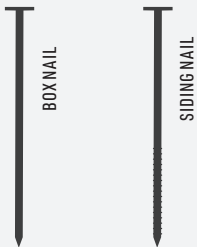

NAIL TYPES



B BOX NAIL - Wide head flat, smooth shaft.

S SIDING NAIL - Wide flat head, ribbed shaft.

! WARNING: Do not nail through any of the over-lapping pieces.

DESCRIPTION

Shiplap Siding is available in a wide assortment patterns with smooth, rough, or saw-textured surface options. Shiplap siding provides a traditional-style appearance. This pattern allows for a 1/2" overlap [B]. Allow for an approximate 1/8" gap [C] when installing patterns 8" or wider.

LEGEND

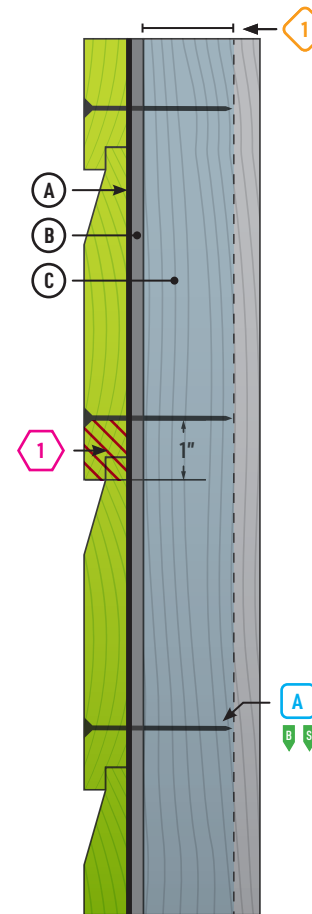
- 1** NAILS MUST PENETRATE 1 1/2" INTO SOLID WOOD.
- 2** USE TWO SIDING OR BOX NAILS PER BEARING 3 - 4" APART.
- A** USE SIDING OR BOX NAILS TO FACE NAIL SHIPLAP PATTERN. ONE PER BEARING
- B** 1/2" = LENGTH OF RABBET. (OVERLAP)
- C** 1/8" = GAP FOR EXPANSION
- 1** POSITION LOWER NAIL 1" FROM THE BOTTOM.
- A** HOUSE WRAP
- B** SHEATHING
- C** STUD
- SIDING
- NAIL DEPTH
- NAIL

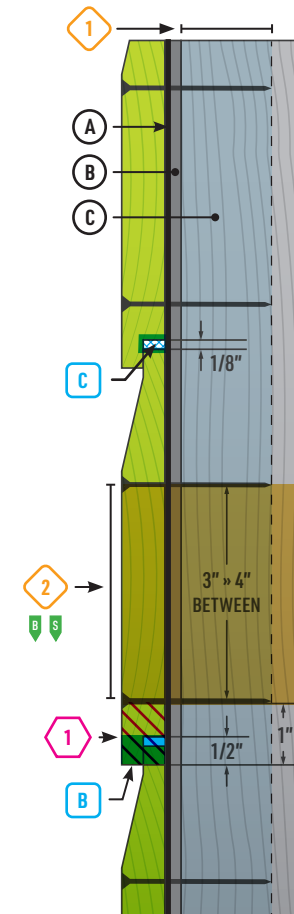
A profile view of the pattern before installation.
